Form Description

If a political committee defines a "parent entity" on their **Statement of Organization** (CRO-2100D) form, they are entitled to accept reasonable administrative support from that "parent entity". These costs must be disclosed as directed in N.C.G.S. 163-278.19(e) on **every report**. This form will be used to disclose any and all administrative support. All committees with "parent entities" **must** submit this form. If there has been no administrative support from the "parent entity", a \$0 should be entered as the total at the bottom and submitted.

If the disclosure report is amended, then all information on this form must be provided again. Amendments to this form are NOT based on individual entries.

When a disclosure report is amended only include changed information and check "Yes" at the top of the page.

Line-by-Line Instructions

- LINE 1. Provide the complete name of the committee this report covers.
- LINE 2. Provide the ID number of the committee.
- LINE 3. Provide the full name of the parent entity for the committee.
- LINE 4. Administrative support items are listed separately. Spaces are available to list additional support services if necessary.
 - a. Common items, including labor costs, are listed on this line.
 - b. List the amount of each type of administrative support received.
- LINE 5. List the total sum of all administrative support.
