Personal Representative Designation of Committee Funds [CRO-3900A]

Form Description

This form is used by candidate committees only and allows the personal representative of the estate of a deceased candidate who did not file a written designation prior to death to file such written designation within ninety days of the candidate's death. The representative is limited in the designation as outlined in 163-278.16B (a) (3), only a contribution to an organization described in section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C. § 170(c)) provided that the organization does not employ direct family members of the deceased candidate is allowed.

This designation is filed at the Board of Elections office where the committee's campaign reports are filed.

Line-by-Line Instructions

<u>Candidate Name.</u> Provide the full name of the candidate.

<u>Committee Name.</u> Provide the full name of the committee.

<u>Personal Representative.</u> Provide the full name of the personal representative of the deceased candidate's estate.

<u>Committee ID#.</u> Provide the committee board of elections ID#.

<u>Level Registered.</u> Indicate the level registered, State or County (if county provide county name). CERTIFICATION – The personal representative of the deceased candidate's estate must complete the designation section, listing the entity(s) to receive funds, and the percentage of or amount of funds that the entity(s) will receive. The personal representative also must certify the Personal Representative Designation of Committee Funds (CRO-3900A) by signing and dating this form.
