Contribution from a Business Account Statement [CRO-6300]

Form Description

This statement allows a committee to accept a check from a business account where the contributor declares that they have no personal account and that the funds are their own personal funds.

This statement is to be filed with the Board of Elections where the committee's reports are filed.

Line-by-Line Instructions

<u>Name of Contributor.</u> Provide the full name of the contributor.

<u>Amount of the Contribution.</u> Provide the amount of the contribution.

<u>Name of the Committee.</u> Provide the full name of the committee receiving the contribution.

Name on the Account. Provide the name that appears on the bank account from which the contribution was made. **Paycheck Deduction.** Check this box if the contribution is a draft from a paycheck.

<u>Signature of Contributor.</u> The contributor is required to sign and date the Contribution from a Business Account Statement.

<u>Note to the Treasurer.</u> Attach a photocopy of the check received with this statement. Maintain this information in your records to be made available upon request.
